HERMANN CARES FOR THE HOLIDAYS

Continuing our history of supporting causes dear to us and our community, Hermann Cares participated in two important causes this winter: Wreaths Across America and Toys for Tots!

In 2018, Hermann Services began our partnership with Wreaths Across America, a non-profit dedicated to coordinating wreath-laying ceremonies at more than 2,500 locations across the U.S., at sea, and abroad. In 2019, we were part of WAA's Honor Fleet as they drove wreaths down to Arlington, VA, and two of our trailers are wrapped with this organization's great cause. This year's National Wreaths

Across America Day was December 17, and Hermann drivers and employees participated by delivering wreaths to the Dayton Cemetery and Long Island National Cemetery.

Clete Cheshire, a Hermann driver who has participated in Wreaths Across America for a few years, said that for him, this cause is personal. "I served in the Army, so it was almost like a mission to honor the vets that passed; then there are the volunteers that you meet at each cemetery you deliver wreaths to, great people."

WHAT COMES NEXT FOR HERMANN SERVICES?

For 95 years Hermann Services has operated out of the Eastern U.S., and in the 1990s expanded its reach to Texas and routes in the Southwest U.S. Terminals and third-party logistics were the primary offerings in the region, but Hermann Warehouse Corporation had its eye on more.

On September 6th, Hermann Services opened the doors on their new warehouse and terminal located on Calvalcade Street in Houston, TX. The property contains ample warehouse and parking space, and it even boasts a refurbished interior and exterior. The first pallets of product arrived on opening day and were unloaded by Chuck Capra, president of Hermann Warehouse Corporation!

In mid-September, Hermann Warehouse Corporation purchased a second location in Texas on East Sam Houston Parkway. With sixteen acres of property, direct access to Sam Houston/Beltway and I-10, and only twelve miles to the Port of Houston, the location is ideal to increase our warehouse, drayage, and transportation services.

Every year, our biggest event is undoubtedly Toys for Tots. A proud partner since 2006 and now a gold-star national corporate sponsor, Hermann Services actively encourages our employees, customers, and community to share in donating toys – or funding the purchase of books and toys – to distribute to children in need during the holiday season. In 2021, Hermann collected over 4,000 toys, and this year we helped collect over two truckloads of toys and bicycles from across all our locations.

Mike Horvath, Driver Planner for Hermann Transportation, routinely helps organize the delivery and collection of Toys for Tots donation

boxes. When asked what he enjoys about this event, he said, “It’s for a really great cause. The memories I have as a kid of Christmas mornings are how special they were and how lucky I was. Meanwhile, there are so many children out there that don’t or never had that experience. So, being able to come together with amazing people for this awesome cause just brings a great feeling, knowing we will be able to make that positive impact and create lasting memories for kids who are less fortunate.”


